<b>Organization and Clarity</b>	The organization of the speech is clear and the points are easily understood.	The organization of the speech is mostly clear and the points are understood with minimal exceptions.	The organization of the speech is not clear and the points are not easily understood.
<b>Use of Facts and Examples</b>	Points are supported with facts and examples.	Most points are supported with facts and examples.	Points lack factual support.
