

The SMEA partnered with C.A.M.P. SASK ARTS to create over 60 comprehensive instructional videos for music education, including lessons on ukulele, fiddle, guitar, song writing, lesson planning, Cree songs and a cultural conversation on Cultural Appropriation. The videos were designed to assist individuals tasked with delivering music education. Additional classroom management videos and resources cover effective techniques, such as handling disruptions and fostering a positive learning environment.

In addition to the videos there are teacher resources linked to provide a complete learning package for both new and experienced music educators. The video series is available on the SMEA website and the SMEA YouTube Channel making them accessible and available to everyone. They can be used in or outside the classroom, whether you are a teacher in the classroom or homeschooling. The high-quality videos are categorized for easy viewing and have lessons for each topic, demonstrating techniques, playing examples, and explanations. Each video clearly defines learning objectives for each lesson to keep your lessons well-structured and on-topic. This will help learners follow along easily.

SMEA has expanded these resources by releasing a curriculum connections package which will help link each video to an intended curriculum outline as outlined by the Ministry of Education.
