Investigating options of Alfresco, Hydra, Islandora and Nuxeo

Regardless of which platform they will need to do development to meet requirements

Cost and resources are YTD.

Solution packs for Islandora virtual machines

Notre Dame early adopters of Hydra much easier now than 2 years ago.

- Use Rails to build interface on top
- Solrizer piece keeps Solr up-to-date
- Quickest implementation is 6 week (metadata)
- Full projects take 2+ months
- Have full-time developers
- Will be borrowing from PSU's scholar sphere

Northwestern has been using Hydra for more than 1 year

- Interesting discussions on campus surrounding DAMS
- Have had 1 developer until recently they now have 2 or 3.

Importance of having a Fedora backend as a solid starting point

- [Tuque API](#) is PHP wrapper around Fedora with CRUD functions
