Every player is playing their role super well, and this team just clicks. With series against most of the other contenders out of the way, TVA has a good chance of entering the playoffs as the overall 1 seed.

SNC Dreaded Dawn (SNC)




Yet another returning team in Group C, SNC Dreaded Dawn have had sort of the same type of season as Avalanche. We've seen this team do well in the LBLCS, including a 3rd place finish in their group last season. There's been a decent amount of players coming in and out of the lineup, with a near even split of playing time between the ADCs. I think that the pairing of SNC Cerionna and SNC Twinberry in the bot lane is a duo we've seen do really well. Dreaded Dawn is still in a really good spot to make playoffs, but I'd love to see them hammer out "their playstyle" over the next few weeks.

COG	Winterfresh	8	Our number 8 and 9 players play a super similar style for their team, but I give the nod to Winterfresh, who has been a bit more aggressive in the lane this season
AVA	Wolfenshaed	9	Wolfenshaed knows their role on the team, and executes it the way they have to: They'll play weak side top, and allow their jungler to invest resources elsewhere to get ahead
LAT	Andreus17	10	When you play primarily tanks top, you are largely dependent on how your team does. With LA Tech having a rough season, Andreus finds themselves rounding out our top lane rankings.

AVA	AVA Crease	3	Captain of the Avalanche, I think Crease has had a major step up in play from their first season in the LBLCS. Crease gave TVA a really hard time on their Poppy, and with other fun picks like Ivern and Nautilus, should be an exciting player to watch heading into playoffs.
DVE	RES Reclaimer	4	Through 12 games, Reclaimer has played 8 unique champions, proving that trying to take away picks is futile.
IE	Tomahawks	5	One of the more carry-oriented junglers, Tomahawks looks to win the game through them, and to their credit, have the 2nd highest KDA and the highest CS/M of Group C junglers.
DTB	Level 3 scuttle	6	With perhaps the play of the season so far (A nocturne R into the baron pit for the steal against LAT,) teams need to be wary of going for objective flips with them around!
BBQ	IsseiSenpai7	7	Slotting into the position matching their name, IsseiSenpai has been good this season, and I think their spot at 7 is more indicative of the strength of Junglers in this group. Perhaps the overall strongest position in the group.
LAT	Spectoras	8	The epitome of "IDGAF". Level 3 Scuttle may fly in to steal objectives, but

			Spectoras will simply walk right into your team as Trundle and swipe dragons away. Spectoras has the type of confidence any jungler should have
SNC	SNC PK	9	A returning staple of the Commercial League, there's only so much flashiness one can exhibit on Zac, Sejuani, and Maokai. Perhaps they can get another Kayn game in this season?
COG	The Magister	10	A couple of players have slotten into the Jungle for COG, and while Magister has had some good games, I'd like to see some consistency in the position over these last few weeks.

IE	Aquarat	5	Another champion ocean, Aquarat has pulled out 11 different picks this season. A lot of utility and poke oriented picks, they've had a solid season thus far.
DTB	SerQwaez	6	Another situation with DTB where a player has played multiple roles, SerQwaez slots in around middle of the pack as a result. Not a knock on their skill, by any means.
DVE	Talkshowxonmute	7	Not a lot of faults to identify in this player, just another scenario where the competition is pretty steep! Their best performances so far have been on the Fizz and Viktor.
LAT	Boldronn	8	The next group of mid laners could go in any order you like, but of the games I have watched, Boldronn has perhaps been the most consistent performer of the 3.
SNC	Onfire1342	9	One of the better farmers of this group, Onfire seems to prefer a more facilitative style, with several games of Zilean, in addition to things that are slower paced like Malzahar and Veigar.

COG	Warbossjustin	10	Despite coming in 10th, Warboss has was able to hold their own against TVA in their 3 game series. A lot of games on control mages this season, but they got to play playmaking champs such as Akali in that series.

TVA	TVA GGGTurtle	1	Another Group where I think ADC is a really strong group, GGGTurtle is one half of one of the best bot lanes in the Group. The threat of Samira is a red flag to any opponent, but they've done well on "less aggressive" picks such as the Varus and Xayah.
DTB	Whale Lord	2	It may be premature to put them this high, but through 4 games, Whale Lord has a 46-10-38 stat line, and has over 8 CS/M. A really aggressive player come the late game, I'm curious to see if they stick in the lineup down the stretch.
PCS	PC Ramcannon	3	Longtime member of the Corps, Ramcannon is having a resurgent S11, avoiding deaths and playing at a high level. With 4 Xayah games under their belt, it may be time for teams to start banning the pick away!
ввQ	Mystic Shinx	4	One of the early adopters of the Sivir that's been gaining prio in Commercial, Shinx has been a consistent force in the bot lane for BBQ boys, and looks to take advantage of teams focusing on Kxtx.

COG	ToNic136	5	Destpite the struggles that COG have had this season, I think ToNic has been one of the better performing ADCs this season, with some really good laning phases that I've seen. One of the better DPM and CS/M players in the role.
IE	Homicidiac	6	If seems like every member of the Infinity Edgelords has slotted around the middle of the pack. I think this team is generally a "team first" team, where no indivdual outshines the rest. Homicidiac has certainly been good, so a 6th place spot is no knock on them!.
SNC	Steve NAE	7	It's been a near even split of playing time for Dreaded Dawn between Steve and Cerionna, but by a slim margin Steve has played more. Their preference is definitely late game monsters, with Aphelios, Zeri, and Jinx in the bag.
AVA	Igabajiff	8	Igabajiff reminds me a lot of the playstyle GGGTurtle has, and by no means does the 8th spot do them justice. Their risk-loving playstyle has taken a hit to their stats, but make no mistake: this is as intimidating an ADC as any in the group. (Nearly 1K DPM)
LAT	Arima Kana	9	It feels kind of unfair to put them in the 9 spot, as they have played a few support games, which really hurt their overall stats. With ADC performances consistently over 8 CS/M, there is a ton of talent here.
DVE	YachtRockBoy	10	As I reach the 10th spot, I truly realize how loaded ADC is in this group. Yacht has by no means had a bad season, and has even gotten their signature Kaisa a handful of times, and looked pretty

solid.

PCS	PC Marshmallow	1	There's probably 3 supports who could have an argument to be in the 1 slot. I give the slightest of nods to Marshmallow, who's really helped Ramcannon unlock another level of play, while serving as a big engage tool.
TVA	TVA Acaamt	2	A returning all star from last season, Acaamt has pretty much picked up where they left off, proving to have insane synergy with GGGTurtle. Potentially the 2nd most aggressive bot lane pairing in the group.
cog	Forgotteñ Metal	3	I briefly outlined their success earlier, but leading the position in KP%, high vision score, and has enabled ToNic to be near the top of several categories. Metal is making sure you can't forget about them on the rift. (I'll see myself out.)
BBQ	Femboy Faygo	4	Despite only playing in 7 games at the time of writing this, Femboy Faygo leads the position in KDA, nearly has 15 assists per game, and seems more than happy to play the engage role that every team needs.
DVE	dongwat3r	5	Bot lane in general appears to be loaded in Group C. Clearing the way for their team quite literally, Dongwat3r leads the group in Vision score per minute.
AVA	Missed the X	6	One half of who I would say is the

			most aggressive bot lane in the Group, the stats certainly show the risky playstyle Missed the X plays. However, give their their signature Pyke, and it may be a GG on the spot.
SNC	SNC Twinberry	7	A returning all star from last season, Twinberry has been interesting to follow, due to playing mostly damage oriented picks. I mean, who else do we see playing Zoe support?
DTB	psychotichainsaw	8	The stats would likely suggest that chainsaw should be higher ranked. They do have the assists and the kill participation to back it up. Their spot here largely is impacted by the vision score, which as a former support main, I will always love seeing high vision score.
IE	NyQuil ColdKilla	9	One of the best names in the entire league, ColdKilla spot likely comes in from their champ pool, with champs like Leona and Nautlius unfortunately designed to be one way tickets in the team fights. Still has done a good job engaging for the squad.
LAT	Greendragon2001	10	Greendragon has been pretty good despite the rough season for the team, with pretty solid vision numbers and a respectable KDA.
