Our upcoming bowling league will be a bit shorter—but just as exciting! We’re upgrading to state-of-the-art string pin machines starting **August 8th**, and we can’t wait for you to experience them.

Overview of the League:

- We will be accepting sign ups throughout the season, but handicaps will be determined after week 3 of the tournament (July 14). Registration for the league is **online**, and can be found here: [Summer Bowling League Sign Up](#)
- Starting **June 23rd**, team members can bowl during regular business hours (check our website for our summer hours: <https://mu.oregonstate.edu/lanesgames>)
 - **Note:** June 23rd – July 17th, we have a bowling class every Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 2-4pm.
 - Bowling will be unavailable for the league during these times.
 - **Note:** Reservations occur frequently in the MU Lanes and Games during the summer, bowling will be unavailable when all of the lanes have been reserved.

 - This calendar lists all of the reservations and classes that reserve lanes during the week and should be referenced when your team is looking for a time to bowl.
- **\$28 per person** [paid on the first week your team meets] includes shoe rental and bowling for the duration of the league (and the warm-up week if registered by June 16th)
- Most weeks will be normal scoring for games, but every once in a while we’ll have games like 8 or 9 pin No Tap!
- The league lasts **six weeks** (the week of **June 23rd - August 7th**), and the winner will be the overall point leader at the end of the last week (announced Thursday August 14th)!

Annual Summer Bowling League Rules & Regulations:

General Rules:

- Each bowler from each team can come down any time we're open during the week to bowl **2 games**.
- Bowlers must bowl their games by Saturday before we close each week.
 - If games for that week have not been bowled by that time, the teammate will receive an individual score of 0.
- Bowled games will be **recorded and verified by the front desk**, be sure to show them your score each week before starting your second game, so they can add it to our spreadsheet.
 - The bowled scores for each week will be used in determining the weekly team score.
 - The first three weeks are used to set the **handicap** (more detail on handicaps later in this document), and points will be assigned retroactively at the start of week 4 in the league.
- **Make-ups and Substitutions are Allowed**
 - If a player is absent and cannot bowl their game for the week, they will be allowed to bowl for the week(s) they are gone in **advance** during a week when they are present.
 - Email MULanes.Admin@oregonstate.edu with the name of the member that is unable to make it, what week they will be missing in the future, and what week they will come in to bowl in advance. *Players cannot bowl for past weeks they have missed, only for upcoming weeks.*
 - **Emails with make-up plans must be emailed by the Friday before the week they are planning to bowl extra games.**
 - If, for some reason, a player is not able to bowl their games in advance, a **substitute** is allowed as long as it is communicated to us (via email) prior to the start of the week they will be missing.
 - The substitute can be anyone not already participating in the League, no handicap will be assigned to them, only their raw score will count.
 - Email MULanes.Admin@oregonstate.edu with the name of the substitute, who they are subbing for, and the week they will be subbing.
 - **Substitutions must be emailed by the Friday before the week they are subbing to be allowed as a substitute.**

Scoring:

- Each team's weekly score is the average of the team member's individual scores
 - The teams will be ranked each week based on their team scores.

- **Points** will be awarded for the following:
 - Depending on the number of teams in the league, points will be awarded based on the team's rank for that week.
 - The top three individual scores will earn bonus points for their team as a bonus!
 - 3 points for the highest individual score, 2 points for the second highest, 1 point for the third highest.
- The team score is **cumulative** and will be updated as the weeks progress.
- A **handicap** will be assigned at week 3 and is used to balance the field!
 - Formula used for calculating a handicap:
 - $\text{Handicap} = (200 - \text{average score}) \times 90\%$
