Steve went on to study Electrical Engineering at the University of Michigan and obtained a master's degree in Electrical Engineering from Cornell University. He was a Principal Design Engineer for Intel Corporation for many years. Steve loved the Wootton community and cherished his friends and the strong academic foundation that Wootton provided him.

The 1989 Steve Curtis Memorial Scholarship (description)

This generous scholarship is open to graduating Wootton Seniors. Applicants should plan to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited community college, or 4-year institution for the entirety of the upcoming school year.

Criteria

All applicants will be asked to provide a personal statement describing the impact that Wootton has had on his/her life and how he/she plan to use their high school experiences in their future educational goals and a resume. The top applicants will be invited to participate in an informal interview with Steve's sister and his best friend from the University of Michigan.

Additional Criteria

- Students must be a Senior in high school
- Cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher
- Intend to pursue STEM field (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math)
- Community Service and/or extracurricular activities

Award

One undergraduate award of \$1989 will be awarded. This is a one-time award.

1. Resume (limit 2 pages)
2. Personal Statement (limit 2 double spaced typed pages) answering the following question:

Describe the impact that Wootton has had on your life and how you plan to use your high school experiences to further your education goals?

After review of the above, you may be invited to participate in an informal interview. This is an opportunity to tell the committee more about yourself.
