Executive Reforms

Royal Prerogatives

- Give the King back the right to name a Seneschal, in exchange for the royal veto (especially the OrgLaw amendment veto)

Monarchism vs. Republicanism

- Likely on hold until we can judge the performance of the next King

Ziu Reforms

Senäts Reform

- Elect half the seats at each election, using a nationwide vote
 - Single transferable (or non-) vote
 - Tafial's MSPAV proposal
- Abolish completely? [difficult from an OrgLaw perspective but seems to have some support]
 - Should there be a referendum?
- Reform as a panel of experts à la Ireland? [You're starting to sound like you're advocating a directorial republic, Litz!]
 - Follow-up question from Mic'haglh in this case would the Senäts lose its ability to veto legislation?

Cosă Reforms

- Mixed-Member Proportional?
- Move back to a Real Cosa?
- What about seats distributed by provincial population and voted on proportionally within a specific province?
 - To allay concerns of gerrymandering, this could be based on votes cast in the last election as opposed to the actual number of citizens assigned to a province. Could also have min/max share of Cosă seats per province to avoid really throwing things out of balance
 - This keeps provinces as electoral districts, but doesn't make them cushy places to get a Senäts seat

"Functional" Reforms

- Fixed election dates
 - Couple with longer terms?

- For: da Schir, Tzara: opens space for more apolitical Talossan activity
- Against: Schivă, Plätschisch: elections provide a boost to Talossan activity
- Counter: Tzara: That's not a good thing
- Compromise: Autófil: What if we tried to increase Civil Service opportunities first and see if we have less need of election-centric boosts as a result?
- [Also, as a note, in my discussions with other micronational representatives as MoFA in 2022 my then-counterpart in Ladonia comes to mind the shortness of our legislative term was surprising to them, because they were confused as to how we ever accomplished anything else]
- What to do about VoC?
 - Remove, swapping to Clarked MoNC [seems unpopular]
 - Remove automatic dissolution if VoC fails
 - Constructive Motion of No Confidence?
 - Maybe the King can consult on appointing a new Seneschal?
 - Can we add other MoNCs without requiring them to be in the Clark?
- What about allowing for non-Clarked motions more generally?
 - What about getting really out there and abolishing the Clark system altogether?
- Make a way to register parties outside the electoral process, i.e. to allow for their own party boards, etc.

Provincial Reforms

Catchment Area Realignments

- Balance out populations
- Retain provincial cultures (assuming any actually exist beyond everyone claiming their province is the best)
- Geographic continuity is preferred
- Make it a periodic review?
 - Redistricting commission?

Mergers

- Top-down vs Bottom-up
