 - DB has escalated the request for lorry route signage on the eastbound A47 to TomMcCabe (also Transport Focus Group)
 - ii. AD Cabinet member for Finance, finances are in good shape but Nutrient Neutrality holdup to planning approvals is a threat to Big Sky housing projects because delays increase costs.
 - iii. Hethersett Post Office in Library SNC councillors have provide funding to enable the service to continue but more funds are still needed. Will provide training opportunities for the unemployed.

 - 1. PH reported that a decision has been delayed until 07/2023
 - ii. <u>2021/0029</u> 6 houses north of SL, previously rejected by SNC awaiting appeal verdict applicant has contended that there is not a 5 year housing supply
 - iii. <u>2022/1086</u> Laburnum Cottage, Green Lane Outline planning permission for new dwelling and garage re-using existing access *no comment*

 - 1. The PC has points out that the development would create significant traffic on a quiet road and that the occupants would be dependent on cars for access to all services other PAs have been refused for this reason.
 - vi. 2022/1870 55 School Lane single storey rear and side extension with internal remodelling
- vii. 2022/1724 LM Business Park change of use of Car Park to Self-Store Container Site
 - 1. PC has requested restrictions on hours of use and monitoring of traffic generated

 - i. 20mph zone on SL difficult to demonstrate adequate support for NCC proposal
 - Can't demonstrate support for buildouts, will ask Highways to proceed with remainder of scheme
 - ii. Provision of westbound lorry route signage on A47 missing since the road was built
