

## “BE GOING TO” FUTURE



be + going to + V1

Use “be +going to+V1” to talk about future plans & intentions / make predictions based on evidence!

*I am going to study English tonight. (+) □ Future plan*

*She is not going to have any problems finding her way around London because she knows how to use a GPS. (-) □ Prediction based on evidence*
