Rainbow Craft Project

Materials

Strips of construction paper cut as follows (1 ea):

* Red 1" x 11"

* Orange 1" x 10"

* Yellow 1" x 9"

* Green 1" x 8"

* Blue 1" x 7"

* indigo (blue-violet) 1" x 6"

* Violet/Purple 1" x 5"

Light blue paper cut into raindrops about 1" in size--(6)

Cotton Balls (8)
Brads or stapler
Glue
Tape
Thread or floss
Glitter Glue

Rainbow Craft Project

- 1. Put the strips of construction paper in rainbow order (will also be size order) following the "ROY G BIV". Line them up so they are all stacked evenly on one end. Staple (or fasten with brad) the end.
- 2. Bend and align the other end (making sure the red is on top) and staple (or add brad) making the arched rainbow.
- 3. Attach floss/thread of varying lengths to each raindrop using glue or tape. Tape the threaded raindrops to the underneath of each end (3 raindrops per side).
- 4. Fluff up the cotton balls by pulling on them. Add glue to one end of the rainbow and adhere two cotton balls to the top side and two underneath (covering up the ends of the thread). Repeat on the other side of the rainbow.
- 5. Add glitter glue to the raindrops for extra shimmer.

Hang up your craft and admire your beautiful rainbow!
