Please state them clearly in the beginning paragraphs supported by related theories in the next paragraphs. INTRODUCTION to CONCLUSION should be **6.000 – 8.000 words**

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RESEARCH METHOD (Font size: 12, Cambria, Bold, Capital Letters, line spacing 1, and no numbering)

This section explains the rationale for the application of specific approaches, methods, procedures or techniques used to identify, select, and analyze information applied to understand the research questions; therefore, allowing the readers to critically evaluate your study's overall validity and reliability. It consists of research design, research instrument, data source, data collection, and data analysis.

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FINDINGS & DISCUSSION (Font size: 12, Cambria, Bold, Capital Letters, line spacing 1, and no numbering)

The research findings in the form of research data are further discussed or critically interpreted with particular relevant theoretical approach. The presentation of tables, images, etc, can be used to support the data. Captions for table is written above it with sequenced numbering so that it can be easily referred to, though not put under the pointing sentence/ paragraph. Line (border) to the table is made minimalist by eliminating the vertical lines and leaving horizontal lines deemed necessary. Captions for images are placed below the picture, also with providing sequenced numbering. One page only accommodates a table or an image with a maximum of two-thirds the size of the page (size adjusted as efficiently as possible).

The discussion is written to critically interpret the significance of the research findings in light of what was already known about the issues being investigated, and to explain any new understanding or insights about the problem after taking the findings into consideration. It should connect to the introduction by way of the research questions or hypotheses mentioned and the literature reviewed earlier in the introduction. However, it does not simply repeat or rearrange the introduction. This section should also explain how the study has moved the reader's understanding of the research problem mentioned earlier in the introduction.
