

Summer Fine Arts Theatre Workshop

This summer, in cooperation with the Phoenix Foundation of Central Florida, Brevard Public Schools will pool the talents of BPS teachers and secondary students to present the Summer Fine Arts Theatre Workshop (SFATW) at Titusville and Satellite High Schools. The workshop features a Broadway production in a "state of the art" auditorium at each site. Upon successful completion, students will receive a high school credit towards their Fine and Performing Arts graduation requirement. Students attending schools located north of the Pineda Causeway will attend the North Area SFATW at Titusville High School.

Students interested in participating in the program should complete and submit the online application through your school's website no later than May 13th.

WHO MAY APPLY?

Any student interested in acting, singing, dancing, sound, lighting, set design and construction, business management or advertising and who will be enrolled in grades 9 – 12 at a BPS high school in August 2026 may apply. This means rising 9th graders may apply but graduating seniors may not apply.

IS THIS COURSE NEEDED FOR MY GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS?

This course meets the required performing fine arts credit for graduation.

WHAT WILL I LEARN?

You will receive instruction in all areas of theatre production such as stage design, set construction, makeup, acting, proper singing techniques, and promotional campaign design. You will produce three performances of a Broadway musical.

WHAT IS THIS YEAR'S SHOW ABOUT?

The jack-of-all trades, Bert introduces us to England in 1910 and the troubled Banks family. Young Jane and Michael have sent many a nanny packing before Mary Poppins arrives on their doorstep. Using a combination of magic and common sense, Mary Poppins takes the children on many magical adventures. Mary Poppins teaches the children and grown-ups that "anything can happen if you let it."

The musical score is filled with memorable numbers which include: "A Spoonful of Sugar," "Jolly Holiday," and "Supercalifragilisticexpialidocious."

Mary Poppins will be directed by **Ashley Bradley** with Minnie Orr, Music Director and Andy Kropp, Orchestra Director.

IS THERE ANY COST?

This project is sponsored through a grant from the Phoenix Foundation of Central Florida. Each student will be asked to submit \$30.00 on the first student day, June 1st, to cover the cost of a t-shirt and occasional pizza lunches. Please note, only cash will be accepted.

IS THERE TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED TO TITUSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING SFATW?

Yes. Bus transportation for Titusville, Port St. John, Cocoa, Viera, and Beachside area students will be provided throughout the workshop at no cost to the student. Several convenient pick-up and drop-off points will be established. Prior to the performances, there may be several evening rehearsals. A separate schedule will be sent home for these rehearsals. **Parents are responsible for providing transportation to these evening rehearsals and to the performances.**

DO I HAVE TO AUDITION?

Yes. The teachers will audition students to determine the best placement for each student. **The final enrollment will be limited to 100 students. Auditions will take place on June 1st.** Remember though, many talents are needed, not just acting, singing, dancing, or instrumental music.

WHAT IS THE PROGRAM SCHEDULE?

****Classes meet Monday through Friday 8:30 AM - 3:30 PM. June 12 and 19 will be 8:30 AM - 12:00 PM.**

The Summer Fine Arts Theatre Workshop (SFATW) begins Monday, June 1, with rehearsals and concludes Saturday, June 28. **All students are required to assist with breakdown following the Saturday, June 27 matinee. Failure to assist on June 27, will have an adverse effect on the student's grade.** There are several rehearsals during the evening prior to "opening night." Students who enroll in the program must attend each of the four weeks in order to participate and receive credit.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Complete and submit the online application (found on your school's website) by May 13th. A detailed information letter concerning auditions, rehearsals and other important information will be sent to your home in May.
