We are deeply committed to supporting every scholar and making sure that every scholar succeeds. Some scholars have more difficulty learning than others and that is okay. Catalyst Public Schools uses a process called "Child Find" to identify and evaluate any child with a suspected disability. Signs that a child *may* have a disability include trouble meeting milestones in one or more of the following areas:

- Vision and hearing
- Speech or communication skills
- Motor control or coordination
- Behavior or social skills
- Intellectual or academic skills
