

Tuition for Institute for Creative Music Lessons & Classes

Individual Lessons

Monthly Tuition (1 lesson per week)

30-minute Individual Lesson: \$33/lesson due a month at a time

45-minute Individual Lesson: \$49.50/lesson due a month at a time

60-minute Individual Lesson: \$66/lesson due a month at a time

Group Lessons, 2-4 students (excluding Denton Jazz Workshop)

Monthly Tuition (1 lesson per week)

45-minute Group Lesson, \$35 per student for each class due a month at a time

60-minute Group Lesson, \$50 per student for each class due a month at a time

90-minute Group Lesson, \$75 per student for each class due a month at a time

Book fees:

\$25 for most instruments (can be shared in families taking group lessons)

Denton Jazz Workshop

10-class School Session Tuition

120-minute weekly workshop: \$350 per semester

8-class Summer Session Tuition

120-minute 2x weekly workshop + 2 30-minute private lessons: \$350

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No student is ever excluded from the programs based on financial inability to pay. The Institute for Creative Music offers scholarships to students in need. We ask you to pay a partial amount if you are able, but we do offer a few full scholarships.

Discounts:

- 10% discount for siblings for all lessons and classes.

Sliding Scale:

Sliding scale payment is currently available for **group classes and workshops**. All are encouraged to participate regardless of ability to pay. The IfCM wishes to be 100% inclusive of all interested people and our programming is made possible by donations from members of the community. Pay what you can to make it possible for us to provide the event to all, regardless of ability to pay. Common sliding scale options include 25% off, 50% off, 75% off full tuition. Attendance Policy

Students are expected to attend scheduled lessons. Please make any changes or cancellations to lesson days or times with at least 24-hour notice. If the student is unable to attend the lesson or needs to arrive more than 5-minutes late, please notify their teacher by text as soon as you are able to. If a student is absent and the lesson teacher is not notified in advance, the lesson will be considered an unexcused absence. Unexcused absences cannot be refunded. Teachers may have the availability to reschedule but that might not be possible. Absences that are excused at-least 24-hours in advance may be credited toward the following month of lessons if it is not able to be rescheduled. In the case of a teacher absence they may attempt to schedule, hire a substitute teacher, or credited towards the following month of lessons.
