Q	What is a breakfast club?				
А	Affordable childcare for working parents/ carers. The children are provided with breakfast and supervised while they play games, draw, read or do homework etc.				
Q	Who can attend the breakfast club?				
A	Any child who is on roll at Sunnymede Junior or Infant School. We cannot provide transport for children who attend other schools.				
Q	Are Infant School children escorted there once the club finishes?				
А	Yes				
Q	What time does the club open?				
А	The breakfast club is open from 7.30am to 8.45am				
Q	How much does it cost for each child to attend?				
А	The rate is £4 per day, per child. There is no reduction for siblings				
Q	Does my child have to attend every day in order to secure a place?				
A	No, we try to be as flexible as possible. However, some days are more popular than others and regulations stipulate the adult/child ratio				
Q	Is it possible to use the breakfast club on an ad hoc basis?				
А	Not generally as spaces are limited. Please telephone the school office for ad hoc availability				
Q	What do the children get for breakfast?				
А	Cereal, toast and fruit juice or milk				
Q	Who supervises the children?				
A	Staff members employed by Sunnymede Junior School and all fully DBS checked
