Per the VADC Bylaws, a call is hereby issued for the purpose of electing officers on Saturday, February 15th at 9:00AM in Salon E of the Downtown Richmond Marriott.

What: VADC Officer Elections

Participation

Any individual who is a current Chair of a City or County Committee shall be eligible to participate in the election.

Officer Pre-Filing

The following positions are to be elected at the meeting following the reorganization caucus:

Chair

Central Virginia Regional Vice Chair

Northern Virginia Regional Vice Chair

Southeast Virginia Regional Vice Chair

Southwest Virginia Regional Vice Chair

Individuals may file for Chair of the VADC **and** a Regional Vice Chair Position. However, if an individual who chooses to do that is the winner of the Chair's election, their name will be removed from contention for the Regional Vice Chair Position.

Candidacy for officer positions must be prefilled in order for an individual to be considered a candidate. All prefilled forms must be submitted by 5:00PM on Wednesday, February 12th, 2020.

Candidates for the Regional Vice Chair Positions may reference the list below to determine which region they are eligible to represent.

In the event that only one qualified person properly files for a position when the filing window closes, they shall be declared the winner and the election for that position shall be cancelled. Should nobody file for a position prior to the closing of the filing window, the vacancy may be filled by a nomination from the floor by the VADC body. Conduct of the Officer Elections

The current VADC Chair, Gene Magruder, shall preside over the election for Chair.

Candidates for Chair shall be given 3 minutes each to speak to the assembled body. The order shall be alphabetical by who is present upon the calling to order of the meeting.

Ballots shall be distributed to those eligible to participate. Participants shall write the name of their preferred choice on the ballot **and** sign the ballot. **Unsigned ballots will not be counted.** The candidate who receives the most votes shall be declared the winner, and immediately assume the title of Chair of the Virginia Association of Democratic Chairs. In the event of a tie, the tied candidates shall do rock, paper, scissors (best 2 out of 3) to determine a winner.

The newly elected Chair of the VADC shall preside over the next elections. Only those Chairs who reside within the regions below are eligible to vote for their Regional Vice Chair. The voting procedure for those elections shall be the same as the election for Chair.
