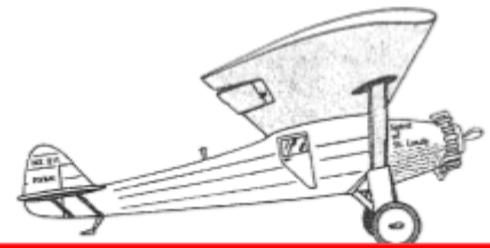

Registration

Updates

The below information are for families that are enrolled to attend Lindbergh Elementary:

- In previous years, class lists were posted on the school doors and this year we will not be doing that. Instead, classroom teachers will be contacting each family via email to inform them of the placement as well as provide some important information for the first week. Expect this on Friday, August 28th.
- Please check the new school calendar as there are some changes, specifically for the first week.

- School start and end times have been changed a little to accommodate for the remote learning. New elementary school time will be from 8:55am-3:50pm. Half days will end at 12pm.
- All Dearborn public schools will be using Schoology and Zoom for our online learning. We will be planning to hold training/information sessions for parents in the coming weeks.

- This year will not look like what it did in the Spring. Students will be expected to be available and ready to learn from the start of the day at 8:55 till the end of the day at 3:50. Please continue working with your child(ren) to set up routines and areas for them at home. Stay positive, we will be working together through all of this and we will try our best to build up their stamina for success.
- There will be live lessons everyday and a set schedules to help with consistency every week. In addition, there will be times added for small groups.
- Learning Labs-These labs will be an opportunity for staff to offer additional support (academically or socially-emotionally) to a small group of students face-to-face. Decisions regarding who, when and how often will be made as a team to ensure we are meeting the needs of our students. The plan is not to start the year with these labs but to have them available once we have systems in place, have a better idea of needs, and can ensure safe transitions for everyone.
- Orientation will look different than in previous years. More information will be coming soon. Please know that we will be working hard to ensure everyone is ready and prepared for when school starts. We know and understand the challenges and importance of knowing what to expect however we will go slow to go fast.
- Chromebooks: We are recommending that every enrolled student in the house have a chromebook or an electronic device to use. We will have another day where we will be distributing Chromebooks (date coming soon). If your child already has one, then there is no need to do anything. If you need

one for your child(ren), please complete the below survey so that we may prepare the correct number of Chromebooks. Please complete by Friday, August 21st.
