Ms. Keane's Classroom Procedures and Expectations

The following list of classroom procedures and expectations are put in place to ensure your safety and boost your learning experience!

Entering the Classroom

- 1. Enter the classroom quietly.
- 2. Take out your homework so that it is ready to be checked.
- 3. Write down your homework in your agenda & follow directions on the board
- 4. A pencil, your Chromebook and your math notebook must be brought to class each and every day. *Homework* will be marked late if it is not in class upon arrival.

Exiting the Classroom

All students must be seated prior to being dismissed from class. You will be dismissed by the teacher only.

Bathroom and Water Fountain

- 1. You must have been given permission to leave the classroom. It is up to you as a responsible student to choose an appropriate time to leave the classroom (e.g. not in the middle of instruction, but rather, during a time of independent work).
- 2. If it is necessary for you to leave during instruction, it is up to you to check with a peer to see what instructions or problems/examples you missed.

Group work

When we work in groups, your cooperation with and respect for group members is essential. If your attention is needed, the teacher will countdown or ring the bell. Please immediately stop what you are doing, raise your hand and listen. * Any kind of disruptions or disrespect will prohibit you from working in the group and you will work independently.

Absences

When you are absent from class, for whatever reason, you should:

- 1. Contact a classmate to see what you missed.
- 2. Check Google Classroom for additional resources that may be available.
- 3. **If you are absent from class due to a band, orchestra, or chorus lesson, you are still responsible to complete the homework due the next day**. You may contact a friend, or schedule a time to come in for extra help the next morning.
- 4. For absences due to illness, you have as many days as you were absent to make up work for full credit. Come in for extra help if you are confused on lessons you missed.
- 5. If you are absent only on the day of a quiz or test, be prepared to make it up **the day you return,** unless we spoke.

Grading Policies - please read carefully

- Homework is usually given every day. **Homework is practice and is not graded for correctness.** A homework rubric will be provided so you understand what is expected to earn the maximum amount of points. *Occasionally, homework may be collected and graded for effort/accuracy.*
- There will be a test or quiz approximately every week.
- Quizzes are usually 25-30 points, and THERE ARE NO RETAKES.
- Quests/Quarterly Cumulatives are usually 60-80 points, and THERE ARE NO RETAKES.
- <u>Tests</u> are 100 points. You may retake ONE TEST per quarter IF YOU RECEIVE A GRADE BELOW 60. These scores are then averaged together.
- Always maintain academic honesty. Plagiarism and cheating are unacceptable and will result in a 0% for that assignment.

Extra Help

Extra help is Tuesday & Thursday mornings at 7:30.. You must bring specific questions/topics to extra help and let me know in advance that you are coming in. We will go over homework in class, so homework questions should be asked during class time for the benefit of everyone (you will have time to ask your questions in groups or with Ms. Keane).

If you are struggling with a topic, seek help sooner rather than later! Do not wait until the day before or morning of a test/quiz to get help.
