

CALL TO ACTION #7: ONGOING: Boycott Monopolistic, Exploitative Companies	
<i>A consumer advocacy group is targeting monopolistic companies. We have the power to boycott!</i>	
Background:	<p>Update - August 4: Activist Jes Craven suggests a “good trouble” boycott to protect fair elections. To “clap back” at the extreme gerrymandering efforts in Texas, consider boycotting beef, which comes predominantly from Texas. If beef is a staple on your menu, consider purchasing from a local farm instead.</p> <p>Since January, boycotts have swept the U.S. in an effort to take back control from corporations accused of monopolistic and corrupt practices. The People's Union USA, a consumer advocacy group, links boycotts to declines in store traffic and stock prices.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">BOYCOTTS: August 1 - 31 Walmart, McDonalds, and Lowes</p> <p style="text-align: center;">September 1 - 30 Pepsico, Uber, and Amazon</p> <p style="text-align: center;">The Summer Blackout List</p> <p>Boycott exploitative brands. Shop at independently-owned establishments and companies like CostCo that demonstrate integrity.</p>
