A consumer advocacy group is targeting monopolistic companies.  We have the power to boycott!	
Background:	Update - August 4: Activist Jes Craven suggests a "good trouble" boycott to protect fair elections. To "clap back" at the extreme gerrymandering efforts in Texas, consider boycotting beef, which comes predominantly from Texas. If beef is a staple on your menu, consider purchasing from a local farm instead.
	Since January, boycotts have swept the U.S. in an effort to take back control from corporations accused of monopolistic and corrupt practices. The People's Union USA, a consumer advocacy group, links boycotts to declines in store traffic and stock prices.
