IV. INPUT ON AND REVIEW OF HIRING HIGH QUALITY TEACHERS AND AIDES

HR Coordinator Jason Rose explained the criteria the district uses to select instructional aides, bilingual aides, and teachers. He shared some interview questions as well as qualifications for education. He asked the committee to give input via a google form for what they think is important for hiring aides. DAC guest Sonia Ramirez said that knowing how to manage student behaviors is important.

IV. CALIFORNIA SCIENCE TEST UPDATES AND PARENT RESOURCES

Ms. Goldstone explained the basics of the CAST for grades 5 and 8, She then showed parents several sample questions from Starting Smarter and shared the CAST parent guide with the committees. DAC vice Chair Normalinda Picaczo asked for clarification about the grade levels tested.

V. FEEDBACK ON CAASPP SCORE REPORTS AND PARENT NOTIFICATIONS

Ms. Goldstone shared samples of the SBAC score reports and the new quantile and lexile reports. She

asked the committees for input on the reports and on how the district could help the reports be meaningful. Committee input follows.

- DELAC member Francisco Acabal said she finds the reports helpful and easy to understand.
- Sonia Ramirez reported that she likes comparing her children's scores over time and that her children like to compare their scores to each other's.
