


Note that the map indicates a rapid spread of your Y chromosome into western Europe. Likely an ancient conquest.




The R1b Controversy (2013)


Haplogroup R-M269 is the most common European Y-chromosomal lineage, increasing in frequency from east to west, and carried by 110 million European men.

2013 Conference: discussed two studies that agreed origin in Europe was **post-Paleolithic**, but differed on whether it entered Europe with Neolithic farmers or more recently.







Haplogroup R1b (Y-DNA)




You are all the Y chromosomes shown to the down to S-28 / RU152. Each Haplogroup is a descendant of an older “parent” haplogroup.”






■ Rib prevalent
■ R1a prevalent






