Evaluation, Judges Comments, and Times...

You **WILL** have a 10-minute time slot for your performance, then you will receive a 10-minute time slot for judges in evaluating your performance. Please be considerate of your time and the judges time to keep the show moving on schedule. There will be an awards ceremony directly after the last group.

Entrance Fee...

The cost for admission into the show will be as follows:

\$15 for Adults, Students, Seniors

\$10 for Children (Age 5 – 12)

Free for Children under the age of 5.

Staff of Performing Ensembles MUST show NCBA Badge upon entrance.

Parents helping with equipment will be REQUIRED to purchase a spectator wrist band prior to entering with equipment.

Please remember that this is a fundraiser, and it costs a tremendous amount of money to host and run a show. Admission wristbands can be purchased in the small gym.

Drum Major performances in the stadium are free admission.

Parking Facilities...

BUS/TRAILERS - Please make sure to complete the bus/trailer requirements for your group so that we can adequately prepare for your arrival. We will assign you a location to park for your bus(es) and trailers upon arrival at the school. The main parking lot should be used for busses and equipment trucks only. **Buses WILL be parked in the same lot.** This parking lot is closest to the show activities.

Due to our school modification & construction **UNFORTUNATELY, INSTRUCTIONAL STAFF WILL NOT HAVE PARKING WITH THE BUSSES & TRAILERS.** Staff members will be asked to park outside of the campus. Please inform your staff members of this prior to arrival.

Drum Majors not traveling with their Winter Percussion/Winter Guard Ensembles will get one parking space per team as a support vehicle. Additional Drum Major vehicles must park outside of campus.

Director/Staff Lounge...

Staff Lounge will be located in the Theater (see map). **Staff, please use your NCBA badges to enter the Director/Staff Lounge.** Please – no students.

NCBA Judge's Check-In & Lounge...

Please check-in at the Directors Check In with the Tabulator and Dr. Mills. The Judge's Lounge will be in the band room. To get food and beverages, go to the Directors Lounge. Mr. and Mrs. Hines' office is the Judge's Lounge.

Drum Major Check In...

Drum major check in will be located in the stadium.

First Aid...

First Aid will be in the Atrium of the School (See School Map).

Dressing Rooms / Restroom...

Located by the main event entrance left of the snack bar & admission sales (See Event Map).

RECAPS & Director Meetings...

The directors/staff of the color guard and percussion units will meet in the Atrium (Center of School) to receive their recaps prior to the color guard and percussion awards ceremonies. Please see the schedule for Director and Staff Meeting times and map for location.

Food...

The Inderkum Music Boosters will be having a concession stand with various snacks and lunch items. Please encourage your students to support this "ON-SITE" location for their food choices.

Warm Up Area...

There will be a designated warm up area for the percussion and guard units should you choose to use it (See Event Map). You will be allowed to set up your equipment for warm up near your designated parking area. You may or may not have room near your designated parking to set up floors.

Restrooms...

We will have ample access to facilities during the competition (See Event Map).

Show Entrance...

The entrance and exit route for the performers is located on the Event map and Gym layout.

Folding Floors Area...

Please see the event map & gym layout for folding floor locations. Please move fast and be safe. We need to keep the show moving and following the schedule.

Sound Check...

Color guards, you may perform a sound check before the competition begins or during breaks.

Sportsmanship...

Please inform your performers that good sportsmanship is expected at all times. Any group(s) not displaying respect for themselves or others will be removed from the competition area.

Cleanliness / Trash...

Custodial Services will be on campus to keep up with restrooms and campus garbage cans. Please make sure to clean up after your groups.
