Respect for Coaches and Officials: Please show respect for our coaching staff, opposing coaches, and game officials. They are dedicated to ensuring a fair and safe game for all participants. Negative comments or actions towards them will not be tolerated and could yield consequences such as dismissal from current and future events.

Sportsmanship: Model good sportsmanship in all interactions. Celebrate our team's achievements while demonstrating respect for our opponents, win or lose.

Positive Environment: Help us create an inclusive and positive atmosphere for everyone involved, including players, coaches, officials, and other spectators. Discriminatory language or behavior that is in opposition of Pemberton's mission statement and/or Core Values is not acceptable and could jeopardize your future participation in sporting events.

Engagement: We encourage you to engage with your child about their experience on the team. The coaches and officials, however, are not available right after the game to discuss the play of their child's performance or any aspects of the game. Coaches need time to evaluate the game and discuss improvements.

Concerns: Should you have feedback or questions, please email the coach. After you have communicated with the coach, and have further concerns or questions, you can contact me directly.

Adherence to District and School Policies: All attendees must follow Pemberton Township School District and Pemberton Township High School policies regarding conduct, safety, and attendance. This includes following guidelines around behavior in the bleachers and around the field.
