

M6. Bronze Serpent

- 1) **Num. 21:4** Then they journeyed from Mount Hor by the way to the Red Sea, to go around the land of Edom; and the people became impatient on the way.
- 2) **Num. 21:5** And the people spoke against God and against Moses, Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no food and there is no water; and our soul loathes this light bread.
- 3) **Num. 21:6** Then Jehovah sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people, so that many people of Israel died.
- 4) **Num. 21:7** And the people came to Moses and said, We have sinned, because we have spoken against Jehovah and against you; pray to Jehovah, that He may take away the serpents from us. So Moses prayed for the people.
- 5) **Num. 21:8** Then Jehovah said to Moses, Make a fiery serpent, and set it on a pole; and everyone who is bitten, when he sees it, shall live.
- 6) **Num. 21:9** And Moses made a bronze serpent and set it on the pole; and if a serpent had bitten any man, when he looked at the bronze serpent, he lived.
- 7) **John 3:14** And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up,
- 8) **John 3:29** He who has the bride is the bridegroom; but the friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices with joy because of the bridegroom's voice. This joy of mine therefore is made full.
- 9) **John 3:30** He must increase, but I *must* decrease.
- 10) **Rom. 8:3** For that which the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God, sending His own Son in the likeness of the flesh of sin and concerning sin, condemned sin in the flesh,
- 11) **2 Cor. 5:21** Him who did not know sin He made sin on our behalf that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

I. A.

- 7) **John 3:14** And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up,
- 1) **1 Pet. 2:24** Who Himself bore up our sins in His body on the tree, in order that we, having died to sins, might live to righteousness; by whose bruise you were healed.

8) **Rev. 12:9** And the great dragon was cast down, the ancient serpent, he who is called the Devil and Satan, he who deceives the whole inhabited earth; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast down with him.

9) **Rev. 20:2** And he laid hold of the dragon, the ancient serpent, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years

10) **Rom. 7:11** For sin, seizing the opportunity through the commandment, deceived me and through it killed *me*.

11) **Rom. 7:17** Now then *it is* no longer I *that* work it out but sin that dwells in me.

12) **Rom. 7:20** But if what I do not will, this I do, *it is* no longer I *that* work it out but sin that dwells in me.

13) **Rom. 7:9** And I was alive without the law once; but when the commandment came, sin revived and I died.

14) **John 12:31** Now is the judgment of this world; now shall the ruler of this world be cast out.

15) **John 12:32** And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to Myself.

16) **John 12:33** But He said this signifying by what kind of death He was about to die.

17) **John 12:34** The crowd therefore answered Him, We have heard out of the law that the Christ abides forever; and how *is it that* You say, The Son of Man must be lifted up? Who is this Son of Man?

18) **Heb. 2:14** Since therefore the children have shared in blood and flesh, He also Himself in like manner partook of the same, that through death He might destroy him who has the might of death, that is, the devil,

19) **John 3:14** And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up,

20) **John 3:15** That everyone who believes into Him may have eternal life.

23) **Acts 26:20** But declared both to those in Damascus first and in Jerusalem and throughout all the country of Judea and to the Gentiles that they should repent and turn to God, doing works worthy of repentance.

- 31) **Rev. 2:22** Behold, I cast her into a bed, and those who commit adultery with her, into great tribulation, unless they repent of her works;
- 32) **Rev. 3:3** Remember therefore how you have received and heard, and keep *it* and repent. If therefore you will not watch, I will come as a thief, and you shall by no means know at what hour I will come upon you.
- 33) **Rev. 3:19** As many as I love I reprove and discipline; be zealous therefore and repent.

- 50) **Gen. 3:1** Now the serpent was more crafty than any other animal of the field that Jehovah God had made. And he said to the woman, Did God really say, You shall not eat of any tree of the garden?
- 51) **Gen. 3:2** And the woman said to the serpent, Of the fruit of the trees of the garden we may eat;

57) **Gen. 3:21** And Jehovah God made coats of skin for Adam and for his wife and clothed them.

58) **2 Cor. 11:2** For I am jealous over you with a jealousy of God; for I betrothed you to one husband to present *you* as a pure virgin to Christ.

59) **2 Cor. 11:3** But I fear lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, your thoughts would be corrupted from the simplicity and the purity toward Christ.

60) **Rev. 12:9** And the great dragon was cast down, the ancient serpent, he who is called the Devil and Satan, he who deceives the whole inhabited earth; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast down with him.

61) **1 Thes. 3:5** Because of this, when I also could bear *it* no longer, I sent to find out concerning your faith, lest perhaps the tempter had tempted you and our labor would be in vain.

63) **1 Tim. 4:1** But the Spirit says expressly that in later times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and teachings of demons

64) **2 Pet. 3:17** You therefore, beloved, since you know *these things* beforehand, be on your guard lest being carried away by the error of the lawless, you fall from your own steadfastness.

4. a.

65) **Rev. 19:7** Let us rejoice and exult, and let us give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready.

b.

66) **Rev. 19:11** And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sits on it called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.

67) **Rev. 19:12** And His eyes are a flame of fire, and on His head are many diadems, *and* He has a name written which no one knows but Himself.

68) **Rev. 19:13** And He is clothed with a garment dipped in blood; and His name is called the Word of God.

69) **Rev. 19:14** And the armies which are in heaven followed Him on white horses, dressed in fine linen, white *and* clean.

70) **Rev. 19:15** And out of His mouth proceeds a sharp sword, that with it He might smite the nations; and He will shepherd them with an iron rod; and He treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty.

71) **Rev. 19:16** And He has on His garment and on His thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

72) **Rev. 19:19** And I saw the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies gathered together to make war with Him who sits on the horse and with His army.

73) **Rev. 19:20** And the beast was seized, and with him the false prophet, who in his presence had done the signs by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshipped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire, which burns with brimstone.

74) **Rev. 19:21** And the rest were killed with the sword which proceeds out of the mouth of Him who sits on the horse, and all the birds were filled with their flesh.

75) **Rev. 20:1** And I saw an angel coming down out of heaven, having the key of the abyss and a great chain in his hand.

76) **Rev. 20:2** And he laid hold of the dragon, the ancient serpent, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years

77) **Rev. 20:3** And cast him into the abyss and shut *it* and sealed *it* over him, that he might not deceive the nations any longer until the thousand years were completed; after these things he must be loosed for a little while.

78) **Rev. 20:7** And when the thousand years are completed, Satan will be released from his prison

79) **Rev. 20:8** And will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together for the war. Their number is like *that of* the sand of the sea.

80) **Rev. 20:9** And they went up upon the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city; and fire came down out of heaven and devoured them.

81) **Rev. 20:10** And the devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where also the beast and the false prophet were; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

82) **Rev. 21:1** And I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth passed away, and the sea is no more.

83) **Rev. 21:2** And I saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

84) **Rev. 21:9** And one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls full of the seven last plagues came and spoke with me, saying, Come here; I will show you the bride, the wife of the Lamb.
