

Terms of Service

By agreeing to commission me, you are automatically accepting my Terms of Service.

- I reserve the right to decline any commission request for any reason.
- I reserve the right to adjust my commission info and pricing at any point in time.
- All payments will be handled via PayPal invoice in USD.
- Commissions are to be paid up-front.
- I reserve full rights to the commissioned image and its distribution and use.
- I reserve the right to post commissioned images on any of the websites I use.
(FurAffinity, Itaku, Bluesky, etc.)
- The commissioner may not claim my work as their own.
- Under no circumstances may commissioned images be used for commercial use or profit.
- The commissioner is allowed to upload commissions I have created for them so long as they link directly to one of my pages and they properly credit me.
- I reserve the right to cancel and refund a commission at any time for any reason.
- With the exception of fandom characters (E.g. characters from TV shows, published games, movies, etc.), I will not draw characters who do not belong to the commissioner without express permission.
- I will not draw mature commissions for anyone underage, nor anyone attempting to get a mature commission on behalf of someone underage. **If I am drawing a mature commission for someone and I find out that they are underage or purchasing the commission for someone underage, I will immediately cancel the commission and will not give a refund. *Do not commission me for a mature piece if you are underage.***

Refunds

Refunds are given entirely on a case-by-case basis at my own discretion. I'm usually pretty amenable to fully refunding before work has begun, but no promises. After I've started drawing, however, refunds will be partial where they're given at all. If I do give out a refund, the

commissioner will receive however much work I've finished up to that point. Please be very certain that you can commit to a commission before you pay me.

The Commissioning Process

At the start of the commissioning process, I encourage commissioners to send as much reference material as possible, even if it's just stick figure poses and stock images lifted off the internet. After we've come to an agreement, I will send the invoice.

The expected time to complete a commission is 2-4 weeks, though especially large or complex commissions may take longer. However, in this case, I will inform the commissioner before asking for payment. Furthermore, despite my best efforts, I am only human, and as such, there may be extenuating circumstances that result in delays; In these cases, I will inform commissioners as soon as I am able, and, if possible, an estimate for how soon I will be able to resume work.

Once the invoice is paid, I will get a thumbnail ready as soon as possible, and at least within seven days. Afterwards, for each stage of the commission, I will submit a work in progress to the commissioner and wait for feedback before continuing. I will do my best to keep commissioners updated, but if you have any concerns, I encourage you to reach out, even just to ask for a progress update or even an ETA on the next stage.

At each stage, I highly advise that the commissioner inform me if anything is wrong with the piece. While I do reserve the right to refuse excessive or frivolous edits, I'm willing to go pretty far to make sure the piece looks right. However, asking me to change something major late in the commissioning process makes it much less likely that I agree to the request.

Once the commissioner is satisfied with the piece, I will send them the full-size image and consider the commission finished. At this stage, I will no longer accept any major changes, unless it is a clear mistake on my part.

In the event a commissioner drops out of contact for two or more weeks, I will consider the commission abandoned. Unless the commissioner reestablishes contact, I will finish the piece to

the best of my ability without further input, then post the image to my gallery and send it to the last known method of contact.

Character Drawings

Character drawings include a basic background. More complex backgrounds can be added for a case-by-case price. Prices listed are for single characters. Additional characters add 50% to the cost per character. See <https://www.furaffinity.net/commissions/scironex/> for examples.

SKETCH

Lines, no color

\$25

+\$12 per additional character

FLATS

Lines plus flat color, no shading.

\$40

+\$20 per additional character

+\$20 for a complex background

SHADED

Lines, full color with shading.

\$60

+\$30 per additional character

+\$20 for a complex background

Reference Sheets

Reference sheets are flat color drawings based on poses of the character. I can do both SFW and NSFW variants of the ref sheet. Up to two additional variations of each pose are allowed. (E.g. naked/clothed versions) Ref sheets include the character name, a short description, and palette by default, as well. I don't do shading on ref sheets. I tend to ask for more input on reference sheets, as details are more vital on them.
