Purpose/Charge: Our primary goal is to identify and dismantle the barriers our undocumented students, students from mixed-status families, and affected faculty and staff face when navigating educational institutions. Our charge is to identify and articulate the issues and needs of undocumented members of the ARC on-campus community and provide advice, information, communication, empowerment, and best practices to guide recommendations to the Student Success Council as well as to provide assistance and support to the Undocu Center and Liaison as needed.

Members of this group are expected to:

- Serve as a liaison for a group, unit, or department
- Be a point of contact for colleagues and undocu-students when needed
- Examine policies and protocols with UndocuScholar inclusive lens
- Participate and be consulted with in regular meetings to discuss the needs and resources of UndocuScholars
- Help make recommendations to the college administration and governing bodies

Functions (not limited to):

- Assessment of financial resources and gaps for undocumented students
- Collaborate in the evaluation of campus services, including their accessibility and effectiveness, and the assessment of campus climate for undocumented students
- Develop an assessment of relevant campus policies related to undocumented students
- Provide recommendations to the president and executive team regarding key policy and service changes
- Collaborate with the executive team, in developing messaging to the campus community in relationship to undocumented announcements.
- Direct connection to LRCCD Undocu-Student Workgroup
- Increasing collaboration with outside private entities that can help with these issues
- Contribute to the planning and overall activities centered on Undocumented students provided throughout ARC
- Undocu Liaison or Designee to represent and update the Student Success Council.
