Classroom	Use your manners. Listen carefully when others are speaking. Let other students learn. Be welcoming and include others. Be respectful in conflicts (staff and peers).	Successfully transition to new activities. Participate actively. Ask questions and get help when you need it. Use failure as an opportunity to learn. Challenge yourself: Do the best that YOU can do.	Be honest. Submit your own work. Comply with classroom and lab rules and procedures. Leave when your local school is dismissed. Take responsibility for your actions and apologize if needed. Use personal technology only when instructed.	Come to class. Be on time. Be prepared for instruction with all necessary materials. Stay on task: Work for the entire time on the class that you are in. Complete all of your assignments and turn them in on time. Clean up after yourself.
Lobby & Hallways	Smile and greet people. Respect the space of others. Throw trash in trash cans.	Use appropriate language, volume, and tone. If you see a visitor, say hello and offer assistance.	Follow staff directions. Return to class promptly. Hold the door for the person behind you.	Report problems to your instructor or the office. Walk away from conflict and drama.
Bathroom	Flush and wash your hands. Be considerate to others by cleaning up after yourself.	Ask to go at a good time.	Use the bathroom that is closest to your classroom. Return to class promptly. Respect the privacy of others.	Report any problems to your instructor or the office.
Driveway & Parking Lot	Wear your seatbelt and drive at safe speeds. Follow posted traffic signs. Give buses the right of way.	Be a careful driver and watch for pedestrians.	Park in designated student spaces. Use good manners. Treat other vehicles with respect.	Bring all of the materials that you will need from your vehicle. Assist those in need.
