A. Introduction

The length of the article must not be less than 6000 words, and must not exceed 10,000 words (excluding footnotes and bibliography). The first sub-discussion in the article must be an “introduction” written in 12pt font size, 1.5 spacing, and add 3pt spacing after writing the sub-title “Discussion.” Articles written in Indonesian must use italic style when writing foreign/English words or sentences. For Arabic words written in Latin letters, do not use transliteration guidelines and write them in italics, such as: *maqasid asy-syari’ah*, *hifz al-mal*. The spacing between paragraphs is 3pt.

In the introduction, the author must write at least: first, the general background of the research (description of previous research gaps), ending with a description of the main issues or research objectives focused on in this study. In the opening paragraph, the author must provide an overview of the development of the research/study to be discussed by providing an overview of how researchers view this theme; second, a literature review in the form of previous research or scientific journals (at least 10 journal articles in the last 5 years). In this discussion, the author needs to emphasize the novelty of the author's research and the significant differences from previous studies. The author needs to thoroughly review previous research on this topic; fill in gaps in the literature, critique existing literature, or reconstruct previous writings to produce new concepts. This discussion can be concluded with a “statement of scientific novelty”; third, it contains hypotheses (if any) or the main arguments of the research.

B. **Methods**

Research methods and/or theories and approaches used by the author to discuss the issues in this study. The methods section in the introduction contains the type of research, time and place of research, research subjects, data collection techniques, data analysis techniques, and other matters related to research methods. In this sub-discussion, the author must also explain the

limitations of the research so that the discussion and analysis do not stray from the focus of the research theme.

C. **Result(s)**

Research results contain research findings, novelty, scientific innovation, study implications, and so on. Research results are not research conclusions.

D. **Analysis and Discussion**

1. **First sub-discussion (*Bold-Capitalize Each Word*)**

In this sub-discussion, the author must present a discussion of various aspects/issues raised in the article by presenting relevant data. The author can assert their position on a particular matter or aspect by constructing arguments and presenting original data for comparison with other researchers or scholarly studies. In other words, the presentation of data and discussion in the first sub-discussion should not consist solely of explanations derived from quotations, but rather a combination of the author's arguments and data.

For the citation format sourced from books, use the following format: if it is a book;¹ if using the same reference;² if using a book consisting of several volumes;³ if referring to a book with the same volume;⁴ if referring to the same book, but it has been passed over by another reference,⁵ only mention the author's last name, the short version of the book title, and the page; if sourced from an anthology/collection of scientific articles that have been published in book form.⁶

For citation formats sourced from materials other than books, use the following format: if using a journal (maximum 5 years old or less);⁷ if sourced from a website, it must be written with the author's name, title of the article, date of publication, website URL/link, date accessed by the author;⁸ if sourced from a thesis;⁹ if sourced from a dissertation obtained from a website;¹⁰
