**ELIGIBILITY**

Open to all Novices, Intermediates, 12&Under Age Group, 13-15 Age Group, and Junior (15-19) and Senior (15 & Older)

Over qualifications: None

Waivers - we are following USAAS 2021 [waivers](#):

**If you have a 19yr old - they can do Jr tech elements**

Junior Championship Age Requirements - For the 2021 season only, FINA has changed the definition of the Junior division (ASAG 2.2). Athletes that are 15-19 to years of age for the year 2021 are eligible to compete in the Junior division. As the Junior National Championship is held under FINA rules (TR 1.1) this waiver automatically applies to this Championship as well as the US Junior Open.

**If you have an athlete swimming up to 13-15, they may participate in 13-15 figures**

13-15 Championships Age Requirement - For 2021 only competitors who do not meet the minimum age requirement under CP 3.4.1 may compete in the 13-15 Championships to complete a routine. At least one competitor in the routine must meet the age requirements under CP 3.4.1.

All competitors must be a registered member of USA Artistic Swimming (Trial Member, Athlete, or Competitive Athlete) by February 21st.

**VIDEO SUBMISSION**

All videos will be uploaded and submitted through the Meet Entry Form in the swimmer entries portion under Video link by February 21st at 11:59pm.

**Each figure or element must have its own separate video per athlete.** Please submit each video link to each entered event on the registration form. Coaches will copy/paste cloud storage (YouTube, Google Drive, Dropbox, etc.) link on registration form.

All videos must be recorded from the judges’ perspective with the athlete’s full body in view (above and below the water). Technical elements will be performed with the left or right side to the camera, regardless of the general requirements for the required elements for technical routines. Technical elements may have stroking into element and out. Video may pan with the athlete. **Videos must be filmed on the same side of the pool as the athlete.**

Videos submitted must be of good viewing quality. If the video is deemed to be of poor quality, the athlete will be required to re-submit within a 24 hour period.  
Suggested minimum video quality 720p at 30 fps.

Please make sure all videos are named with the following naming conventions:

Video file names should be hyphen (-) separated.
