Lesson Procedure:

Total Time: 5 weeks - for our schedule this is a once every 6 day cycle for library instructional time

Day 1- Students pick their state book and begin reading to familiarize themselves with the state.

Day 2- Students are given a state outline questionnaire to begin filling in by using the book. They will see that not all information can be found in one resource.

Day 3- Students bring their chromebook to class and they will be introduced to the template and they can begin filling in their information.

Day 4- Students are introduced to a second resource, **World Book Encyclopedia online - Student Edition**, which will give them current information for some questions.

Day 5- Students should be finishing up inputting answers and adding pictures on certain slides. Students who are more comfortable with the platform or more quickly become familiar with the resources and are finishing ahead of peers will become peer buddies to those needing support.
