

## **Feedback Received by TAP FIRC on Spring 2021 Draft Of Framework30 SLOs**

### **Background**

In April and May, 2021, representatives of the Transfer & Articulation Program (TAP) Framework Implementation Review Committee (FIRC) distributed a draft of revised Student Learning Outcomes (SLOs) for the “Framework30” 30-credit common core for TAP degrees to all 17 CSCU institutions, with a call for feedback.

The call for feedback was accompanied by a document titled [“Presentation of the Draft Framework30 SLOs and Plan for Finalizing the Revision Process, April 2021 - December 2021”](#).

The proposed revisions to the SLOs were the product of a multi-year assessment cycle that included a review of system-wide quantitative and qualitative data and collaboration between faculty from both the CCs and the CSUs in system-wide workgroups.

The FIRC membership consists of 17 voting, teaching-faculty members: one representative from each of the CCs and one representative from each of the four-year institutions (CCSU, ECSU, SCSU, WCSU, and COSC). There are also two non-voting, non-teaching faculty with expertise and experience in transfer and articulation: one from a community college and one from either a CSU or COSC. The committee [meets monthly](#).

### **Feedback**

Detailed and extremely helpful feedback was received from faculty at 12 institutions — ten Community College campuses, and two Connecticut State University campuses — with suggestions for revision or comments on all of the SLOs.
