Abstract—An abstract is a brief summary of a paper to help readers quickly ascertain the purpose of the study and according to research needs. Abstracts must be clear and informative, provide a statement for the problem under study and the solution. The abstract length is between 90 and 250 words. Avoid unusual abbreviations and define all symbols used in abstracts. Using keywords related to research topics is recommended.

1. INTRODUCTION

Articles are made into 1 column pages with A4 paper size. For Top Margin 3 cm, Left Margin 3 cm, Bottom Margin 2 cm, and Right Margin 2 cm. Manuscripts are made using Microsoft Word, single-spaced, 10 pt Times New Roman, and no more than 8 pages. The introduction must describe the background of the research, the solutions offered and comparable related work. If there are citations in the article, it is MANDATORY to use [1], [2] and so on using the Mendeley citation tool with IEEE format. Terms in foreign languages are written in italics.

It is recommended for Authors to use the following article structure: INTRODUCTION (min 700 words) - RESEARCH METHOD (min 500 words) - RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (min 1800 words) - CONCLUSION (min 200 words). The maximum article contains 8 pages.

2. RESEARCH METHOD

The minimum number of references used is 15 references.
