The abstract is written in Times New Roman, Justify, 10 pt and 1 space, with no more than 250 (two hundred and fifty) words and no quotations. The abstract must cover the entire essence of the research based on the data and facts contained therein. It consists of the background, methods, results, and conclusions. It is written in one paragraph and followed by 3-5 keywords. The abstract is written in two languages (English and Indonesian).

INTRODUCTION (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold)

Introduction should contain background, literature review/previous research (4-5 main references), problem formulation and/or hypothesis, as well as purpose and urgency of the research. (Times New Roman, 12 pt)

RESEARCH METHODS (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold)

The author must clearly describe: type and research approach, data collection techniques, data analysis techniques, data processing methods. (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold)

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold)

Authors should explain the results of the study in detail. Include tables/figures with clear captions if necessary. Relate the results to the research questions and relevant literature. (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold)

CLOSING (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold)

Contains conclusions and suggestions. Conclusions answer the problem formulation concisely and clearly, while suggestions are recommendations for further research or implementation of the results. (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold)

REFERENCES (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold)

all references cited in the text of the article must be written in the bibliography section. This should include references obtained from primary sources (consisting of scientific journals amounting to 70% of the entire bibliography) that have been published in the last 10 (ten) years. The remaining 30% can include research articles or research reports (theses, books, and other relevant publications). Writing the bibliography using APA STYLE (latest edition) and citation using footnotes (Chicago manual of style -Full Note). It is recommended to use Mendeley.

HASIL DAN PEMBAHASAN (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold)

Penulis harus menjelaskan hasil penelitian secara rinci. Sertakan tabel/gambar dengan keterangan jelas jika perlu. Hubungkan hasil dengan pertanyaan penelitian serta literatur yang relevan. (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold)

PENUTUP (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold)

Berisi kesimpulan dan saran. Kesimpulan menjawab rumusan masalah secara ringkas dan jelas, sedangkan saran berupa rekomendasi untuk penelitian lanjutan atau implementasi hasil. (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold)

DAFTAR PUSTAKA (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold)

semua referensi yang dikutip dalam teks artikel harus ditulis di bagian bibliografi. Ini harus mencakup referensi yang diperoleh dari sumber primer (terdiri dari jurnal ilmiah sebesar 70% dari seluruh bibliografi) yang telah diterbitkan dalam 10 (sepuluh) tahun terakhir.
