KEY INSIGHTS:

- MyData for Children has been hanging in the discussions for quite some time, and many initiatives are already existing regarding children's rights and designing for children (see Miro Board)
- There is potential in many projects to include the children's dimension. An exercise to identify and map is a necessary first step
- There is a good opportunity between the academic and the service providers dialogues, where one can inform the other

- The rights of children are missing from GDPR (from Isabelle de Zegher): In the EU Data Governance act [ref] - point 24 - they say the following... Nothing about children.. and this does not make sense to me as far as children as concerned.

*Data cooperatives seek to strengthen the position of individuals in making informed choices before consenting to data use, influencing the terms and conditions of data user organisations attached to data use or potentially solving disputes between members of a group on how data can be used when such data pertain to several data subjects within that group. **In this context it is important to acknowledge that the rights under Regulation (EU) 2016/679 can only be exercised by each individual and cannot be conferred or delegated to a data cooperative.***

IDEAL OUTCOMES OF THIS GROUP:

1. Finding/building a dynamic cross-sectoral ecosystem to build the solutions together. Understand the different roles that actors have in the ecosystem.
2. Find and develop use cases (e.g, with existing initiatives, cities, governmental agencies, etc)
3. Conceptualise new business models for MyData4Children
4. Identify and act upon legal shortcomings and changes needed to protect and empower children regarding their data

KEY NEXT ACTION:

Identify the ecosystems and existing initiatives where MyData 4 Children fits and network / collaborate with them (e.g., skills data space, City of Helsinki, Fujitsu?, UNICEF, etc.)

DECISION:

We will first explore the field, contact those in the feasible/most promising ecosystems, etc. before we commit to start a charter.

We will organise a follow up meeting in 2 weeks.
