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## Description:

Students will visit the various regions of California on Google Earth and sketch a storyboard of each region with a partner. They will then use Kidpix to draw their regions, export the picture as a JPEG file, and then upload and insert their files onto a Google doc. They can then share this with parent and teacher.

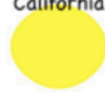

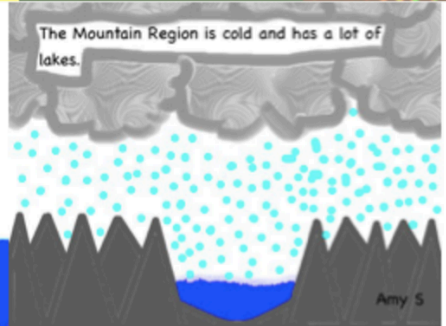
