- Question from Dan Doyle: For the grafana essentials workshop afterward, is that intended for newcomers or is there going to be info geared towards more advanced users?

- Currently we have a data source in Angular. When's the right time to move it to ReactJS?
 - Want to make sure the APIs are in a stable state for Grafana 7.0.
 - Won't be any ground-breaking
 - If there will be changes, they won't require you to rewrite your entire plugin.
 - New plugin tutorials for Grafana 7.0 (work in progress)

- Big theme in Grafana 7.0 are revolving about panels and visualizations.
 - Building a new architecture for working with data
 - Introducing new data structures, like the Data Frame.
 - Lets you define things in a unified way across panels.
 - Panels don't have to reinvent the series overrides etc.
 - Expanding on what you can do in explore.
- Feature request: Git integration, where changes within Grafana will be committed back to a Git repository
 - This is something we've been looking for a while.
- Which is the idea to migrate current panels (i.e. piechart) to new beta panels? They are going to keep the current functionalities?
 - We fully aim to support backwards compatibility
 - The external pie chart will be deprecated.
- Improvements to user stories around scripted dashboards?
 - Torkel: Has not been touched in ~5 years, not really deprecated, but no love either. Trying out replacement, playing around, will probably deprecate them then.
 - Unsure what the future for scripted dashboard is going to be
 - How does it relate to Grafonnet?
 - A scripted dashboard is executed during runtime
 - Used for more complicated use cases
- There is a long-term issue #448 about Internationalisation. Do you plan to add it to new Grafana versions?
 - TO: Not any time soon; it's a lot of work
 - TO: Possibly we have some bandwidth to get to that after the ReactJS migration
- Question: Is it possible to share dashboards across organizations?
 - TO: No, and probably won't be supported. The idea is that organizations are isolated; multi-tenancy. Consider using teams instead?
- Have you thought of implementing marketplace for plugins (kind of like an app store)? If you did, can you share some of your thoughts on how this could work?
 - Torkel: It has come up, though not something we've considered for now. Potentially something we'll revisiting in the coming years, after the new changes to the plugin architecture. What's missing right now is for community members to offer commercial plugins to sell.
- Could creating templates for email alerting be more intuitive?

- We're looking at ways to make it easier.

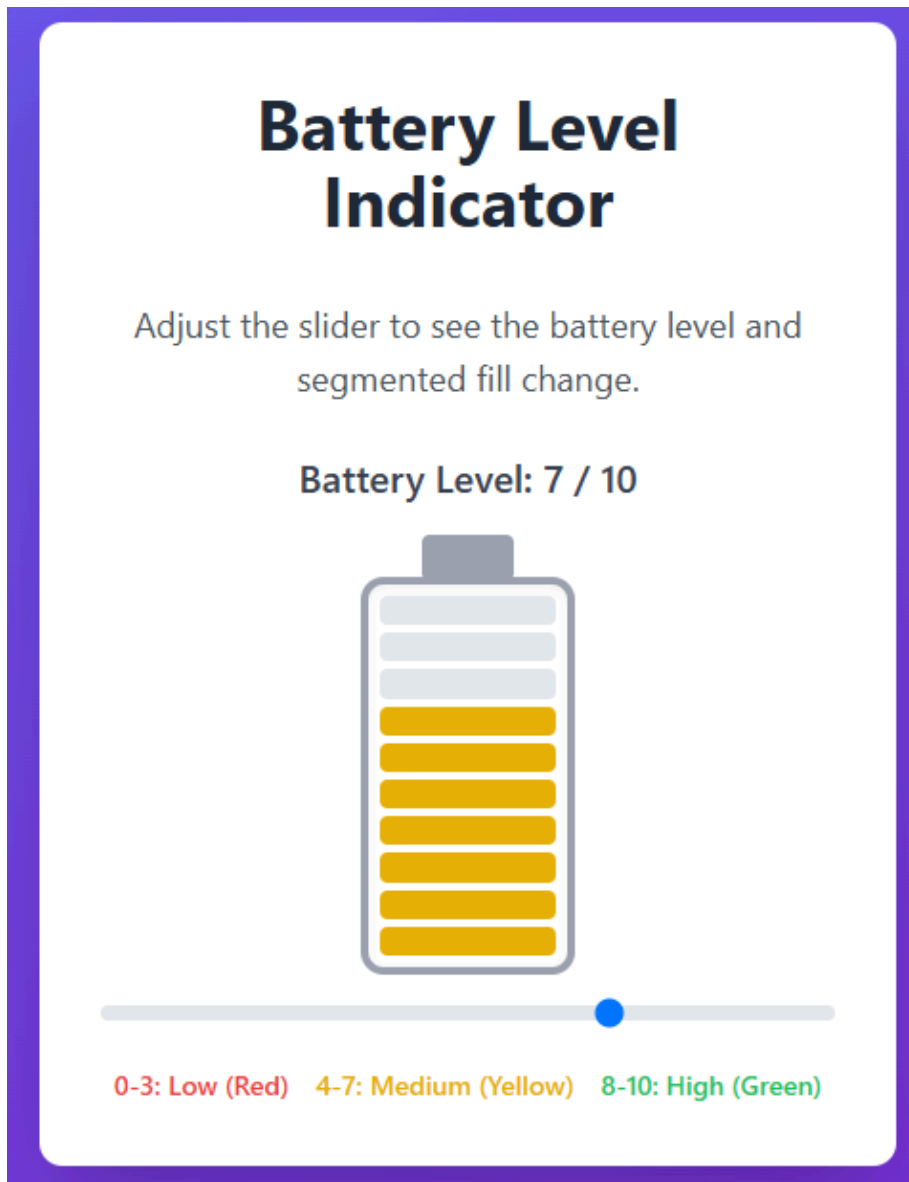
- React/Angular
 - Has several integration
 - Is this the time to start migrating to React plugins?
 - Added benefits if you go the grafana-toolkit way
 - Lot of work left though
- Welcome

- Multi viz panels
 - Torkel demoed rendering of multiple queries, very impressive.
 - Being able to have multiple visualizations with one query is very interesting
 - In 6.5(?) we added a dashboard data source that you can use to reuse the same query
 - Not super intuitive yet, but we're working on it
 - Related to transformations? Yes, but that's behind a feature toggle.
 - In Grafana 7.0 we're looking to support transformations for data sources that may not have support for it
 - For Grafana 7.0, we're working on extracting visualizations
 - "What is the growth of this things?" Trying to visualize it in multiple ways, but it keeps hammering on the data source.
 - Really doing the same query multiple times
 - Could crush your database
 - Some users have very heavy dashboard. Could DDoS the database.
- PR policy during angular / react transition
 - We'd like to add some features, but they would be done in Angular.
 - Would they get thrown out once someone writes them in React
 - Not a great use of anyone's time
 - Small changes are fine.
 - Bigger changes will probably get a no
 - Example: Checkbox template variable
 - What's the right way to go about this?
 - Template variable code is one of the less beautiful parts of Grafana :)
 - Currently working on migrating some of the template variable parts to React
 - Won't be a straight port, will try to improve it as we go.

- Explore functionality
 - How would you go about hooking up the specifics of Explore?
 - Explore is a new part of the codebase, written in React so, not much documentation for Angular.
 - We're using the same component for multiple data sources
 - Some parts of Explore have been internal, but has been extracted into the grafana ui package.

- This is more of a **feature request**, it would be really nice if the query and datasource could be a part of the alert so you can parse it from the notification template. Or even better, I would like to get two explorer URL directly from the alert, one that contains the entire query that I ran to generate the alert. The second one containing the "samples" query (without all the sum and > 0 kind of checks).

Background: Migrating from kibana to loki and generating an alert that gives our developers direct link to the error message and with all the bells and whistles.

The alert overview don't give you the possibility to easily keep on working by filtering

span_id and keep on exploring what caused a specific log. I want to get our developers directly to explore with 0 clicks. Currently solving this by manually adding the query to a custom annotation and I do lots of black magic in notification template, and it's very brittle.
