Roll Call (above): Acceptance of Minutes: Mr. Gazzillo moved, and Mrs. Evans seconded to accept the minutes from the January 11, 2023, all members were in favor. New Business: Fire Drill/Security Drill - Mr. Bach stated the Intercom worked 'better'. Mr. Warnero said an ALICE Tabletop drill for February where all the teacher lockdown but discuss with students the best scenario's to do depending on the incident. There will also be a component for offices to complete. Mr. Warnero will send out the scenario for discussion, this will be completed next Thursday. PCCD GRANTS Update both Elk Lake and SCCTC – Mr. Gazzillo finished the reports financials, signatures and submitted. \$70,000 will go to alarms on all doors, key fobs on all shop doors so doors can be shut at all times. Dr. Cuomo mentioned how to track fobs when people leave to return/disable. They tried the put the remainder of the grant of \$1,330 for the SRO but was denied so sent that amount back. Elk Lake Dr. Cuomo stated purchased new radios, guiderails for around the 6 th grade playground. Which Mr. Weisgold brought up the drive entrance is open being it is also a parking lot with possible recommendations of a van, gate or fence during recess. Mr. Gazzillo stated the SCCTC would make a gate to put on that side for safety. Key door alarm system, hardware was ordered prior to price increase. Elementary will all be rekeyed to match the high school. Mental health YAP paid for at least 2 years. NEPA Healthcare Clinic Update – Dr. Cuomo informed the committee by the end of this week should be 89% complete, the only item left is the countertops where are being decided on and ordered. Then whatever NEPA Health supplies to be installed. Dr. Cuomo also informed that the Handicap access will be through the Administration Central office doors. Would like to enclose at least one of the compressors outside the NEPA Health doors this summer. Mr. Gazzillo asked if they will have their own IT system. Dr. Cuomo stated they use their own Laptops now through the NEPA Health's system. They are also looking at possibly be open 4 days a week starting in the 2023-2024 year. Possibly NEPA Health will also have dental services available as well. Mr. Place asked about them getting a Fob, they will have their own and yes the outside door will be locked and patients will have to be bussed in by NEPA Health. Old Business: Monthly walk-through – missing 1 for February. Monthly Emergency Drills – Completed for January's drill. Other Items: A. Any concerns from committee members. Roof project for Junior High/Main Office area will be completed this Spring prior to Graduation. They do not need access to the building, very little interruption. This summer will install new ceiling tiles. Mrs. Griffiths asked if there has been any update with the phones between Elk Lake and the SCCTC? Mr. Tripp wasn't available, but Dr. Cuomo stated he knew they were still working on it; it is an outside agency issue we are trying to get resolved.
