Families,

What a great start to Winter Programming and the beginning of 2020! I hope you all have had a wonderful new year so far!

- 1. Our school will soon be starting a school safety team. We would like parent voices on this team. If this is something you would be willing to help with, please speak with Chris Lawson or Tanya Sousa.
- 2. On Tuesday, January 21st Vermont Agency of Education will be here to conduct an "Integrated Field Review". During this visit, a team will come to CES and meet with students, teachers, parents, and administration. They will also visit some classrooms. The team consists of area educators as well as members from the AOE. The parent meeting is at 2PM on that day. Thank you to those who have said they will attend. - 3. Charleston Elementary School receives Titles money from the Federal Government. This money is used to help students access their learning. This year, Charleston receives money for intervention, and Prek. We also benefit from NCSU coaches and financial support to help with parent/family engagement. - 4. Recently, NCSU, and the CES board adopted a new head lice policy. This policy gives direction on working with families and students with lice to help limit the time away from school. While head lice is a great nuisance, it is not disease carrying. Health experts do not support exclusion of children from school because of headlice. As the policy states, the school will work with the family to ensure proper treatment has occurred and provide support where needed.
