At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed public meeting on July 15, 2024 with a quorum present, a quorum being five commissioners, Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 3C voted x-x-x by a voice vote to approve providing support for Cleveland Park artist <u>Claire</u> <u>Sharp's</u> Fiscal Year 2025 Public Art Building Communities Grant Program (PABC) Application.
