MEDICATION POLICY

The camp staff cannot give medication to the camper unless:

1. Medication is in the original container in which it was purchased. This includes prescription, over the counter, vitamins, or any other pills/liquid medications.
2. Prescription medication comes with a pharmacy label attached.
3. Camper's Name is clearly marked on all containers
4. Dosage of Medication (mg) is marked on all medications.

Pills that arrive unmarked, in plastic bags, pillboxes, etc. are NOT acceptable and will not be given. It is the camper's responsibility to go to staff for medication. Reminders will be given. All medications (prescription or non-prescription) must be kept by staff.

STANDARD ASTHMA FIRST AID PLAN

1. Sit the child down and calmly reassure them. Do not leave child alone.
2. Without delay, shake inhaler and give the child inhaler according to prescribed directions.
3. Wait 4 minutes. Contact Camp Director and/or nurse.
4. If there is no improvement, repeat steps 2 & 3.
5. If no improvement after an additional 4 minutes, call an ambulance immediately and state that the student is having breathing difficulties.
6. Repeat steps 2 & 3 while waiting for ambulance.

If at any time student's condition suddenly worsens, or you are concerned, call an ambulance immediately.

Please list any changes to the Standard Asthma First Aid Plan (above) if your child has a different plan:

- Please notify me if my child regularly has asthma symptoms at camp.
- Please notify me if my child has received Asthma First Aid.
- In the event of an asthma attack at camp, I agree to my child receiving the treatment described above.
- I authorize camp staff to assist my child with taking asthma medication should they require help
- I will notify you in writing if there are any changes to these instructions.
- I agree to pay all expenses incurred for any medical treatment deemed necessary.

What to Bring/Wear

- Pen and notepad (Bibles for lesson times will be provided)
- Casual Clothes that can get dirty (maybe even paint or tie dye on them)
(please no spaghetti straps, tube tops, or crop tops.)
- Wear tennis shoes for games/activities
- Prescription Medication (if needed) (please keep the original package and fill out a Medication Form. Place it in a zip lock bag with the camper's name clearly written on it.)
- Reusable Water Bottle (Name clearly on it)

What Not To Bring:

- -Cell Phones, electronic games, tablets, radio, smart watches, laptops, iPads, air pods, or other electronic devices are not recommended and are the camper's responsibility. They can not be used during camp and will be taken away if they are seen by camp staff.
- -Toys, stuffed animals, any personal items that could get lost or stolen.
- -No knives, weapons, or anything that could be used as a weapon.
- -No fireworks.
- -No tobacco, drugs, or alcohol.
- -No Bad attitudes.
- -No snacks (lunch and snacks will be provided)
