Daily Class Expectations

- Students are expected to be in the Webex session at the beginning of every class period.
- Students follow their daily class schedule posted in Infinite Campus
- Students will have class materials ready when they log in to WebEx.
- Students will exhibit positive online behavior: mute their microphone when not speaking and use chat features appropriately.



Attendance

- Teachers will take attendance every class period, including Advisory.

- Students need to check their teachers' Schoology pages each day.

- Include first and last name and class hour in any messages to teachers.



GMail and Infinite Campus

- Students need to check their ISD194 Google email (GMail) accounts every day.
- Include first and last name and class hour in any messages to teachers.
- Students need to check their Infinite Campus account every day.



Office Hours

- Teachers have office hours 5 days a week. Teachers' office hours are posted on their Schoology pages.
- Teachers will use office hours to work with students individually or in small groups and to connect with parents/guardians to support students.

We know the return to Distance Learning is not easy for our students. The routine and structure of our daily schedule in Distance Learning provides consistent academic expectations, consistent academic experiences, and continued academic progress. Our overall goal is to ensure that school is still school and that our students continue learning in a safe environment.
