We will be weighing pigs at the barn starting at 6 pm. You can come early if you want (advisors will be there at 5 or 5:30 pm). We will then load tack and supplies to haul to the fair (Merrick and Keegan) will help unload at fair. We expect all members with pigs at the barn to be at the barn to weigh and help load stuff.

Sunday - I would like to weigh the pigs again on Sunday evening.

Monday

Noon - everyone needs to meet at the HS barn to weigh and haul pigs if you have a pig at the HS barn then once loaded, go to the fairgrounds. We will be at the fairgrounds at 2 pm waiting to unload our animals. This is just for pigs at the barn (they are allowing us to haul barn pigs in earlier than normal as a trial run).

- You will need to bring your passes
- Parking will be charged since the fair is going on. If you plan on meeting at the fair, we can pick you up at the Food Pavillion Parking Lot down the road. Text Davis or Rightmire to pick you up.
- Some pigs will be 3 to a pen, some 2 to a pen, and some 1 to a pen. This is due to where pigs were housed (with other pigs or not) and to minimize fighting and injuries to to ensure student safety.

1 pm - Mrs. Jones will be at the fair to start setting up. We will need to put up the lattice and the 2x2's and decorations before pigs arrive. Also flush out the fair waterer and put $\frac{1}{2}$ " plugs in the fair waterers. We will be using our barn water for the first couple of days to minimize sick pigs and diarrhea.

2 pm -3 pm - help unload pigs @ NWWF Henry Jansen Swine Barn, put up stall cards, fill up waterers. Train pigs on water. Pigs stay on diet from barn.

Tuesday

6:00 am - 8:00 am - Haul in for pigs if you kept at your house. Link to haul in map and directions

8:00-10:00 am - Vet check in pens (pigs). Stall cards must be up. We will have them Monday night

7:00 am - 10 am - Weigh pigs at fair. You must have your <u>quality assurance form</u> (orange, blue, green) and complete (have your premise ID# - small white round tag) written on the form - do this at the fair before you weigh in while the pig is confined to a pen.. You must have any worming or medications listed. <u>Information for pigs at the barn is located here</u>. After weigh in feed Depth charge (and water) and regular swine feed. They are no longer on a diet but do not overfeed or they will get sick.

11:30 am - General Exhibitors Meeting in main Henry Jansen Barn arena.

12:00 pm - Swine Exhibitors Meeting in swine arena

12:30 - 3 pm - wash pigs and start using show product (Rightmire will help). No clipping pigs unless long hairs.

5:00 pm - Swine Type - need official dress!!

There will be an exhibitor meeting at 11:30 am in the main arena. You need to be there. We will meet as a chapter briefly right after the swine meeting. We will be holding a brief chapter meeting after the general meeting.
