

 - o KR: Mrs. Hansen and husband put a lot of good work on the flyer, will get full color
 - o KR: Like to go conservative with numbers. Ending year with \$18,128?
 - o PW: asks whether there's a separate amount for fieldtrip?
 - o PW: Coloma estimate bus \$850.23.
 - Families paid \$14 each to make the leather pouches and panning gold. Parents that drove separately paid separate for parking. We me ask for \$14 that can't afford, maybe 2 in my class.
- SF: did you get anything from 5th grade? A trip for May? KR: No

- o Taking the classes to Mondavi for performances. (will subtract -\$2500 for remining field trips)
- KR: Budget numbers doesn't include anything from 6th grade yard sale and assuming we don't make anything from pints and pins
- TD: What are teachers needing?
 - o PW: Writing Journal \$250 for my classroom. Math multtives from partern.
 - Mrs. Sullivan headphones from Amazon with \$14.99/piece.
 - SF: Pushing iReady younger and younger. On going diagnostic tool all the way to Kinder.
 - SF/PW: Google form was sent last year, when and how you use for you students.
 Melissa Edsell would sent the inform. Melissa Edsall took care of amazon order for me.
 - o KR: Will send a googledoc to reachers, and get ME to review them again
 - MS: Nathan said it will be 13 staff members, we are not accounting for everybody for the grant. Counselor qualified last year. We want to make equity to everyone.
 - SF: Counselor RSVP teachers have access \$2500 from the district, can guide who desperately needs the funds. At least the 14 classroom teachers. 15 next year and will be fully staff. PE teachers may want it equipment and Band. Will need to budget for next field trip.
 - o KR/SF: funding would be different. Slide Park in October. Asking for funds to pay for transportation cost.
 - KR: found new fundraiser like cool magazines
 - PW: Did yard sale go out to all students? Where is that being stored:
 - o SF: No not info yet.
 - MS: Sugg estimate high and just not spend.
 - o SF: recommend planning for classroom 14ppl x \$250 = \$3500
 - \$3000 in transportation (plan for next year) shouldn't be \$4300/bus next year.
