Introduction Script

Main Test Tasks

Please go to the Gale Support site and share your screen. Next, we're going to give you 3 hypothetical tasks that users might do using the Gale support site. We're going to ask for you to try and complete these tasks. Please remember to think out loud during the process so we can better understand how you tackle these tasks.

Task 1: Find a scavenger hunt about sustainability within Gale in Context: Opposing Viewpoints

Imagine yourself as a teacher who is planning to have a discussion on sustainability. You are looking for activities for your student to do during class. From the home screen, please try to locate a Scavenger Hunt activity that relates to sustainability within the product "Gale in Context: Opposing Viewpoints".

[After task completion] What are your thoughts on this task?

Task 2: Locate a Gale eBook on-demand training tutorial via Product Support that provides support on creating a custom collection for Higher Education Librarians.

Imagine yourself as a librarian who is aiming to learn how to organize their library's ebook collection. Beginning from the home screen, please try to locate an On-Demand training tutorial via Product Support that aids library staff in creating custom collections, regarding their school's eBook collections.

[After task completion] What are your thoughts on this task?

Task 3: Locate a webinar for higher ed users with a duration of 30 minutes.

Imagine that you are a teacher, and your students have a school-wide seminar, giving you an extra hour during this week. You have 30 minutes that you plan to use watching a webinar for higher education staff. From the home screen, please locate a webinar that is 30 minutes long and for the higher ed users that you may be interested in watching.

[After task completion] What are your thoughts on this task?
