

Languages for All (LFA) at University of York

Practical information for choosing the right level from 2026/27

At the University of York our LFA courses can be taken for credit, i.e. as part of your studies if you are a UoY student, or as a non-credit option, open to all. Here is an overview of our strands:

Study a language from September to May: 22-week LFA courses

1. **LFA for-credit for UoY students:** 20-credit modules taught over 2 semesters (2 weekly hours, 22 weeks) prior approval by your home department. These were known as YLEs or York Language Electives until 2025/26, are covered by your university fees and UoY students can take the module at the level of proficiency that suits you at any stage, depending on your prior knowledge.

When to apply?

- Continuing students (UG Year 2 and beyond): apply through e:vision, ideally in Window 1 for option module choices (February/March) or in Window 2 (summer).
 - New students (UG Year 1 and PGT students): select an LFA module for credit as your elective in August/September, if you have room in your programme, alongside your other modules. Check with your department or supervisor for more information on whether you can take electives in Year 1/your PGT course.
2. **LFA non-credit open to all:** fee-paying language classes open to all: UoY students, staff and members of the public, to take alongside your studies, work or other commitments. Taught over 22 weeks, 2 weekly hours. Students can opt in to take the assessments to receive a certificate of attainment.

When to apply?

- Registration opens in August and closes in late September.

Depending on your other commitments and programme requirements, for 22-week courses, students can move from the LFA credit to the LFA non-credit strand to continue to the next level on your language learning journey.

Study a language as a non-credit option: LFA short courses

LFA short courses: fee-paying language classes open to all, typically available from February to May (8 weeks, 2 weekly hours). English language short courses are also available from September to December.

When to apply?

- Registration opens 5-7 weeks before the start of the course and closes on Sunday a week before classes begin, at 23:59. Check [our website](#) for more information.

Over your time at university, students can mix and match the non-credit and credit strands of our LFA courses, moving from one pathway to the other. This allows for progression even when you don't have room for a language elective in your programme in any particular year.
