# **Ongoing Mutual Aid and Funding for families**

- LA County Launches Household Relief Grant
  - eligible households will be able to apply for grants ranging from \$6,000 to \$18,000, depending on household size and composition. Funds can be used for essential expenses such as housing and living costs, funeral expenses, and repairs not covered by other forms of assistance. The application period will close March 12, 2025
- <u>Recouping lost groceries</u> (that were purchased with EBT/CalFresh)
- <u>Emergency Assistance Fund</u> (For low-income families who earn below 50% of the area median income and who have lost their homes due to the 2025 LA wildfires.)
