HMCC provides childcare and preschool for children ages 6 weeks-5 years of age. We offer both full-time and part-time year-round care Monday through Friday from 7:00am-5:15pm. Our Universal Preschool program, offered under Act 166, provides funding for 10 hours of preschool for children who are 3 or older before September 1st. This program runs for 35 weeks during the school year. Many of our children receive the 10 hours of Universal Preschool curriculum and then stay for the remainder of the day/week. We do offer the option for a child to attend only the 10 hours of Universal Preschool (two-5 hour days) for free under Act 166. Drop off for these 10 Universal Preschool hours is 8:00am-1:00pm, 2 days a week.

Spring Hill School has two preschool classes of up to nineteen children and a team of three teachers. The Tuesday/Thursday class consists of three and four year olds. The Monday/Wednesday/Friday class consists of four and five year olds. Most children are enrolled for two years. Children arrive between 7:45 and 9:00. There are three schedule options for length of day. Morning only program hours are 7:45-12:45, mid-day program is 7:45-3:00 and full day is 7:45-5:15. Extended day may available to children on alternate afternoons. Spring Hill School accepts Act 166 Universal PreK funding, VT Child Care Subsidy and has a generous scholarship program. The three-year-old morning only program (T/Th) is ten hours/week and tuition is covered by Act 166 funding.
