The Immersive Reader is accessed by opening a document in the cloud from Office 365 and selecting View > Immersive Reader


Microsoft Office 2019

The Immersive Reader can be accessed by opening a document on your computer and selecting View > Learning Tools or Immersive Reader

Microsoft Edge

The Immersive Reader is built-in to the new Microsoft Edge browser and is installed on all school-issued Windows and Apple computers. The Immersive Reader icon will appear in the URL bar when a website can be read using Immersive Reader. Try a Wikipedia article to test it out.

Immersive Reader Icon in Edge




Immersive Reader in Chrome
