Program Description

Incoming Grade 8 TDSB students are eligible to register for the Reach Ahead (**GLD201**) course.

If it is announced that only Remote learning is available, students who are registered for in-person classes must be ready to pivot to remote learning (synchronous).

In-Person learning, students will interact face-to-face with a teacher. Students will be with their teacher.

Remote Learning, students will interact with their teacher online daily. Students must log in to Brightspace every day

Classes will run Monday through Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.
Attendance is MANDATORY.

Successful completion of this course counts towards the OSSD.

Incoming Grade 8 students are eligible to register for the Reach Ahead (**GLD20E**) course.

The e-Summer Program is entirely delivered asynchronously online. The teacher will deliver a live lesson each day for about an hour that will be recorded and available for viewing after the lesson.

- Students are encouraged to attend the daily live lesson but may choose to access the recording at another time in the day. Students work independently during the remaining course hours, which is asynchronous.
- Students are able to connect with their teacher for one-on-one conferencing for assistance throughout the course.
- Students are expected to log-in to Brightspace every day and should commit about six hours daily to their course. e-Summer courses count toward the OSSD and the mandatory e-Learning graduation requirement.
